The Historic Preservation is preparing a Historic Preservation Plan for New Jersey. The Plan is intended to guide statewide historic preservation planning and decision-making. The Plan is intended to provide direction for federal preservation expenditures, and to guide State, county, and local government agencies, private organizations and individuals in their efforts to protect and preserve New Jersey’s rich and diverse history. The goal is to develop an integrated Plan, combined with the activities of other preservation and planning organizations, so that New Jersey’s preservation actions meet priority needs and protect our treasured resources for the future.

In creating a new Plan to guide us in the next five years, the New Jersey Historic Preservation Office is working with Preservation New Jersey and others to learn the most important actions needed to preserve New Jersey’s valuable historic resources. Gathering the opinions of our citizens is a vital step in developing a revised five year plan for historic preservation in New Jersey.
